

What is the Barbados national energy policy (BNEP)?

This Barbados National Energy Policy (BNEP) document is designed to achieve the 100% renewable energy and carbon neutral island- state transformational goals by 2030. These include: Provision of reliable, safe, affordable, sustainable, modern and climate friendly energy services to all residents and visitors.

Does Barbados need a BNEP?

The BNEP provides a basis for building on these successes while seeking to expand the use of these and other renewable energy technologies such as wind and biofuels. However, even as Barbados promotes the development of renewable energy, there are ongoing plans to explore for fossil fuel resources offshore.

What does an energy consultant do in Barbados?

The Barbados government had modelled a need for 204MW of energy storage by 2030 to support its renewable energy goal, with 144MW by 2025. Moves are already being made to increase storage capacity: the government ordered BLPC to initiate a 50MW energy storage pilot programme and established an energy storage pilot tariff framework last year.

The Barbados Energy Transition and Investment Plan is under development and will be officially launched during the SEforALL Global Forum in Barbados by President Mia Mottley. Barbados aims to become the first 100 percent renewable energy country as it moves away from a petroleum-based economy.
