TAKE NOTICE that, at 10:30am UK time on Friday 9 August 2024, the British Indian Ocean Territory Court of Appeal will hear, in open court, the appeal in the matter of The Commissioner v The King (on the application of VT & Ors) (No. 3) [2024] BIOT CA (Civ) 3. The time estimate for the hearing is one day.

The islands were constituted as the British Indian Ocean Territory in 1965 by an Order in Council under the Royal Prerogative. This comprises all the islands of the Chagos Archipelago and until June 1976 also included the islands of Aldabra, Desroches and Farquhar which were then ceded to the Seychelles, of which they are now part.

Formerly administered as part of the British Crown Colony of Mauritius, the British Indian Ocean Territory (BIOT) was established as an overseas territory of the UK in 1965. A number of the islands of the territory were later transferred to the Seychelles when it attained independence in 1976. Subsequently, BIOT has consisted only of the six ...

After 1945, as Britain was decolonizing former colonies, one last colony--the British Indian Ocean Territory--was created. On November 8, 1965, Queen Elizabeth II and her Privy Council met to create an "Order in Council" --also known as a royal decree--called the British Indian Ocean Territory 1965 Order.
