How do you store a long-term drinking water container?

Store your long-term drinking water storage containers in a relatively cool place. Avoid heat, which may promote growth of algae, etc. A good rule-of-thumb is ideally between 50 - 70°F. I keep mine on the 1st-floor slab where it's always cool. Some suggest to keep water containers from direct contact with concrete (long term).

Can you put water in a storage container?

Never use the water in the storage container itself. Pour the water into another container to wash clothing, take a bath, or do anything else as you will want to keep the storage containers clean and ready to use again if you find access to more water. Use one container at a time.

How long can you store water?
