Why are Chinese battery companies flocking to Europe's electric vehicle market?

Chinese battery companies are flocking to Europe's booming electric vehicle (EV) market to profit from the European Union's (EU) ambitious goal to ban all fossil fuel cars by 2035. This year, Chinese companies have raised more money through share sales in Europe than in the U.S. for the first time.

Will Chinese companies be able to develop batteries in Europe?

New criteria requiring Chinese businesses to have factories in Europe and share technological knowhow will be introduced when Brussels invites bids for EUR1bn of grants to develop batteries in December, according to two senior EU officials. The pilot could be rolled out to other EU subsidy schemes, they said.

Are Chinese batteries coming to the UK?

The UK is eighth with just 20GWh. In addition to battery production that has already been announced, a slew of Chinese brands, from BYD to Great Wall and Nio, plan significant sales growth in Europe. This will, in time, mean vehicle assembly and even more battery plants that are also likely to use Chinese technology.

Why are battery makers focusing on Europe instead of North America?

Mostly shunned from North America because of the U.S. Inflation Reduction Act, which seeks to reduce American companies' dependence on China's supply chain, battery makers in China have instead focused on Europe, the world's second-largest market for electric vehicles.
