

# Compensation for land acquisition of photovoltaic panels

Will PV project develop on agricultural land?

First,PV will gradually withdraw on agricultural land. In the face of the strictest arable land protection system,PV project development should avoid competing with food and other crops for light sources,and comply with the national guarantee of arable land retention and permanent basic farmland requirements.

How does land use policy affect the development of PV industry?

The development of PV industry cannot be separated from policy support and constraints, and the land use policy is related to the definition and decision making of a series of issues such as the establishment of PV projects, revenue and whether they are illegal .

How can China support the development of PV power industry?

To support the healthy development of the PV power industry and clarify land use management policies,the Chinese State Council,the Ministry of Land and Resources,the National Energy Administration,and other departments have formulated several policy documents before and after to guide matters related to land use in the PV industry.

Does China need a lot of land to develop a PV project?

China,being the largest developing country and the largest PV utilization country,has been actively pursuing the adoption of PV technology to meet its growing energy demands while reducing greenhouse gas emissions. However,the vigorous development of PV projects requires substantial land resources,which are relatively scarce.

How does National Grid implement the compulsory acquisition of land?

Generally,following the processes for compulsory acquisition of land and land rights under both Part 1 of the Compulsory Purchase Act 1965 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981,National Grid will implement the compulsory acquisition provisions of the Order by serving a Notice to Treator,if the Order provides,by a General Vesting Declaration.

Where can a PV project use unused land?

In abandoned land,barren hills and slopes,agricultural sheds,mud flats,fish ponds,lakes and other construction of local consumption of distributed PV power stations. Conditions under which PV projects are allowed to lease unused land such as Gobi,desert and wasteland.
