Supporting Documents: Detailed site plans, elevations, and full specifications of the panels will be necessary. Compliance with planning permissions and building regulations is crucial for a lawful solar panel installation. Homeowners must conduct due diligence to ensure all regulations are met.

Do I need planning permission for a solar PV project?

The rules apply to both solar thermal panels and solar PV. However, permitted development rights do not always apply as there are a few exemptions. If your project falls into one of these, you will require planning permission unless you can make any adjustments to your plans. Exceptions can include:

Do I need planning consent to install solar panels?

However, checking whether planning consent is required can be an all-important step prior to installation. If your property lends itself to it, solar panels can be easily added to either the roof, or in your garden if it is large enough. Can solar panels be built without permission?

This is because they generally fall under permitted development rights, which allow homeowners to make reasonably sized changes without getting permission.
