Are Turks & Caicos a self governing territory?

The Turks and Caicos Islands participate in the Caribbean Development Bank,is an associate in CARICOM,a member of the Universal Postal Union and maintains an Interpol sub-bureau. The United Nations Special Committee on Decolonization includes the territory on the United Nations list of non-self-governing territories.

What are the natural resources of Turks and Caicos?

The primary natural resources are spiny lobster,conch,and other shellfish. Turks and Caicos contains three terrestrial ecoregions: Bahamian dry forests,Bahamian pineyards,and Bahamian-Antillean mangroves. The two distinct island groups are separated by the Turks Island Passage.

The Turk's Head Cactus is one of the national emblems of the Turks and Caicos Islands where it loves the dry climate and thrives in exposed areas. It is named after the distinctive reddish cap that sits on top of the green cactus and looks like a Turkish fez (cap).

The crest of the Turks & Caicos Islands is a pelican between two sisal plants representing connection to the rope industry. Nahum Shereshevsky, 31 May 1997. The circular badge on the first flag was introduced sometime before 1904. The arms were granted 28 September 1965 and the shield from the arms replaced the circular badge on the flag in 1968.
