

Does El Salvador have a target for renewables in end-use sectors?

El Salvador does not currently have targets for renewables in end-use sectors, either. Establishing targets for renewable energy in transport, heating and cooling, agriculture and industry could contribute to a further scale-up of renewables in the country, and help achieve emissions reduction targets while creating new business opportunities.

What is the energy supply in El Salvador?

In 2019, total energy supply in El Salvador reached around 156 600 TJ (see Figure 5). That year, the renewable energy source with the largest share as part of the primary energy supply was bioenergy (19.6%), followed by hydropower (3.5%), geothermal energy (3.4%), and solar energy (1.1%) (CNE, 2020).

How much electricity is produced in El Salvador?

The institution currently has a total installed capacity of 204.4 MW and a net production equivalent to 21.8% of the electrical energy produced in El Salvador. CECSA, a CEL subsidiary, is a company dedicated to the generation of electrical energy through small hydropower plants.

Will El Salvador get a new PPA for renewables?

This project already holds a PPA, which was awarded during the first energy bidding process in El Salvador back in 2012. It will also cover a large part of the distribution companies' demand. Following the plant coming online, the allocation of new PPAs for renewables will likely depend on the growth of electricity demand and future energy policy.

Does El Salvador have a renewable resource potential?

While the country has recently made significant advances in diversifying its energy supply, much of its renewable resource potential remains untapped. In terms of installed power capacity, by 2019, El Salvador's solid biomass had reached 298 MW while biogas totalled nearly 7 MW (IRENA, 2020a).

The new National Energy Policy 2020-2050 aims to diversify El Salvador's energy mix and take advantage of the country's significant renewable energy resource potential. At the same time, the policy highlights the need to reduce dependence on fossil fuels and mitigate the impact of climate change. This means adopting energy storage, efficiency

With the implementation of the first 100% smart grid and the follow up of its medium- and long-term modernization plan, AES El Salvador is betting on the future of electricity distribution to bring a world class service to its 1.5 million customers.

El Salvador's masterplan for renewable energy development indicates that up to 682MW of renewable capacity could be added by 2026. This would be comprised of approximately 160MW of small hydro, 200MW of solar thermal, 90MW of solar PV, 60MW of wind and 60+MW of geothermal along with smaller capacities of biomass and biogas.

A document, prepared by the JICA, identifies El Salvador's potential for developing renewable energy projects. El Salvador's potential to develop renewable energy generation projects has been identified in a Master Plan of the same name, which will be presented officially by the National Energy Council (CNE) in March.

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Energia Del Pacifico (EDP), a joint venture between the US-based power generation company Invenergy and the El Salvador-based Quantum Energy, is the owner and developer of the project. Estimated to cost

US\$702m (\$877m), the Acajutla LNG power project represents the biggest energy infrastructure investment in the history of El Salvador.

In a move towards sustainable energy, the Executive Hydroelectric Commission of the Lempa River (CEL) recently inaugurated Talnique Solar, El Salvador's first state-owned photovoltaic plant. This initiative, planned, constructed, and operated by CEL's subsidiary, Inversiones Energéticas (INE), signals a significant step in the country ...
