Is the electricity supply in Bangladesh reliable?

Bangladesh is ranked 134th out of 144 countries when it comes to the reliability of electricity supply. In 2012, the total net installed electricity generation capacity in Bangladesh was 5719 MW, but only 4162 MW were considered usable. The country's power demand was 6066 MW.

What type of energy does Bangladesh use?

In Bangladesh, despite the fact that the energy sector uses and covers varied products including electricity, petroleum products, natural gas, coal, biomass and solar, electricity is the most commonly used form of energy in the country. The policy and decision makers are mostly pre-occupied with electricity.
