

Does Azerbaijan have a strategic energy cooperation with the EU?

Commissioner for Energy, Kadri Simson, said: "The EU and Azerbaijan's strategic energy cooperation has shown all its flexibility and dynamism. In 2019, there was only gas on the horizon. Not today. The Southern Gas Corridor has evolved to become a forum for cooperation also on renewables and electrification.

How much gas will Azerbaijan deliver to the EU this year?

EU Commissioner for Energy Kadri Simson confirmed that under the memorandum Azerbaijan is "expected" to deliver an extra 4 billion cubic meters (bcm) of gas to the EU this year (bringing the total to 12 bcm) and to increase transfers to "at least" 20 bcm by 2027.

Will Azerbaijan double its gas supply to the European Union?

Azerbaijan will double its gas supplies to the European Union, according to President von der Leyen. Von der Leyen stated: "Indeed, with this MoU, we commit to the expansion of the Southern Gas Corridor. This is already a very important supply route for the European Union, delivering currently more than 8 billion cubic meters (bcm) of gas per year.

How many bcm will Azerbaijan Export to the EU?

Thus, Azerbaijan will be able to increase this year's export index of 11,5 billion to the EU by only 2,5 billion. So, Azerbaijan's exports to the EU may total 14 bcm. Energy Minister Parviz Shahbazov said the Southern Gas Corridor is working at maximum capacity to meet the forecast target of 11,5 bcm of gas.

Did Azerbaijan Export gas to Turkey?

The Ministry of Energy of Azerbaijan confirms this redirection, saying that a total of 8,5 billion cubic meters of gas was exported to Turkey; that is, even less than the amount that Turkey claimed to import.

Overall, Azerbaijan's gas exports for the year totaled 16.4 billion cubic meters, marking a 3.1% increase from the previous year. In July 2022, Azerbaijan and the European Commission signed an energy memorandum in Baku, agreeing to double the volume of transported gas.
