

French Guiana forms of energy storage

How will EDF power French Guiana?

It will be connected to French Guiana's electricity grid through EDF's substation in Saint-Laurent-du-Maroni. The facility will provide reliable and clean electricity to power up to 10,000 French Guiana households. It will meet half of the energy demand in Saint-Laurent-du-Maroni and the Mana commune of French Guiana.

Is biomass a source of electricity in French Guiana?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings. How much daylight does French Guiana have?

French Guiana is situated in northern South America, close to the equator. It, therefore, boasts 12 hours of daylight throughout the year, which will allow the CEOG solar-cum-green hydrogen power project to operate consistently as a baseload facility all year round.

CEOG will provide cheaper and firm power all year long, day and night, to 10 000 homes in Western Guiana. Combining a photovoltaic plant and mass storage of energy in the form of hydrogen, CEOG is the alternative to a classic diesel power plant.

French firm Voltalia has started building the largest energy storage system in French Guiana made up of two separate lithium-ion batteries. The Mana Stockage facility with 10MW / 11.3MWh of storage is located close to Voltalia's under-construction Savanes des Pères project within the Toco storage complex, which couples a 2.6MW / 2.9MWh battery system ...

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CEOG is the first power plant worldwide to store in the form of hydrogen as many renewables produced locally to generate reliable electricity for local use. CEOG is a significant example of non-polluting power production. It will contribute to Guiana's energetic independence and set a reference worldwide.

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The CEOG system is a combination of a solar park, hydrogen long-term energy storage and a battery (short-term energy storage) to produce 24/7 baseload power. It is the first time that a renewable energy project supplies a grid through a capacity-based Power Purchase Agreement, usually used for thermal power plants.
