

Will Mozambique liquefied natural gas project be restarted?

Japan's Mitsui & Co is collaborating with TotalEnergies and the Mozambique government to finalise plans for restarting construction of the \$20 billion Mozambique liquefied natural gas (LNG) project, CEO Kenichi Hori said on Thursday.

Is Mozambique ready for the next wave of energy projects?

What energy sources are available in Mozambique?

Mozambique has abundant energy sources available for exploitation. As of 2021, the country was ranked first in energy potential of all the countries in the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP), with an estimated energy capacity of 187,000 MW. Available energy sources include coal, hydroelectricity, natural gas, solar energy and wind power.

How much natural gas does Mozambique have?

Mozambique has proven natural gas reserves in excess of 180 trillion cubic feet. In the north of the country, AREA1 is under concession to TotalEnergies. AREA4 is concessioned to ENI and ExxonMobil.

What is the largest power station in Mozambique?

The 2,075 megawatts Cahora Bassa Hydroelectric Power Station (CBHPS) across the Zambezi River, is the largest power station in Mozambique. The power station is operated by Hidroelectrica de Cahora Bassa (HCB), a Mozambican parastatal company.

Is Mozambique a good place for energy security?

"Mozambique has the necessary attributes and resources to help address energy security supply concerns in Asia and, most recently, Europe," said Estevao Pale, ENH chairman and CEO. "The discovery of world-class gas reserves in the north of Mozambique factually confirms this statement.
