

# How long can a rice storage box keep rice

How do you store rice for a long term?

Since rice is typically stored in the pantry and isn't temperature regulated, make sure to keep it in an airtight container where oxygen can't seep in.

How do you store brown rice?

Similar to white rice, brown rice lasts longer when stored in cool conditions. For the longest storage life, keep your brown rice in a cool location with temperatures of 40 degrees Fahrenheit.
