How much does a 5 kW solar panel cost?

A 5 kW solar panel system will generate around 3,703 kWh per year. In most residential cases, solar panel costs tend to range between £4,216 and £9,837. A 5 kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is usually more suitable for larger homes, typically four or more bedrooms, and cost roughly £9,837 to install.

How much does a 3.5 kWp solar panel system cost?

A 3.5 kWp solar panel system would typically require around 10 solar panels (at 350 W each) and cost between £5,000 and £10,000. \*kWp stands for 'kilowatt peak'. This is the amount of power that a solar panel or array will produce per hour in prime conditions.

How many solar panels are in a 5 kW system?

There are approximately 14 solar panels in a 5 kW system, with each solar panel having a power rating of around 350 watts. Monocrystalline solar panels -- also known as black solar panels -- could reduce the number of panels you need too.

How much do solar panels cost?

But the average solar panel system of 3.5kWp will cost around £7,000 to install, according to estimates from the Energy Saving Trust. How much does a 5 kWp solar array cost?

In some cases, a 5 kWp solar PV array will be sufficient to meet those energy demands. A 5 kWp solar system will typically require around 15 solar panels at 350W each and cost between £8,000 to £12,000.
