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By the end of 2027, Azerbaijan plans to commission nine solar and wind power plants, collectively generating an energy potential of 2 gigawatts. Furthermore, by 2030, the country intends to develop an additional ten wind and solar power plants, enhancing its total capacity to up to 5 gigawatts.

At COP29, the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) signed a financing agreement of USD160 million for its first private-sector renewable energy project in Azerbaijan, marking a major step in expanding green infrastructure across the Caucasus region.

In 2023, Sungrow completed Azerbaijan's first and largest utility-scale solar project, a 308 MWp plant that has now been operating for nearly a year. The plant generates an impressive 500 million kilowatt-hours of electricity annually, providing clean energy to more than 110,000 homes.

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Gas and oil make up two-thirds of Azerbaijan's GDP, making it one of the top ten most fossil fuel-dependent economies in the world.
