Are solar panels legal?

However, it's crucial to understand that while installing solar panels is legal, certain conditions must be met. For most domestic properties, solar panel installations are considered a "permitted development" and do not require planning permission, provided they respect certain size criteria.

Provided you've got an appropriate roof for it, a solar installation will save you money on your electricity bills.
