Can solar panels be installed on a building roof?

Fires resulting from electrical faults is the most common cause of loss associated with roof mounted solar PV installations.

Do solar panels damage your roof?

While solar panels themselves will not inherently damage your roof, an improper installation can lead to problems down the line. It is crucial to ensure that the installation is done correctly by a professional, or with thorough research and proper planning if you choose to do it yourself.

Can solar panels be installed on a combustible roof?

In general terms, solar panels should not be installed on combustible roofs unless some form of fire protection can be installed between the panels and the roof e.g. concrete panels or pebble ballast. 3. Location of solar panels

Can PV panels be installed on a new roof?

Where PV panels are to be installed on an existing roof, consideration should be given to the extra weight they will add. If you are planning to install panels on a new roof as part of a new build or reinstatement, it is important to be aware of the different risk implications of different roof types (e.g. flat vs pitched).

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?
