Kazakhstan's largest solar power station "Burboye Solar-1" LLP was commissioned in July 2015. Since then, during a year of operation, the solar power station produced over 38.4 million kWh. Besides "Burboye Solar-1", the Zhambyl region implements nine projects of alternative energy sources.
