The project, which is about 65 per cent complete, is expected to be completed by the end of December 2024. The \$59 million plant, which is being constructed by the Bui Power [...]

Construction work on a 50 Megawatts peak (MWp) solar pow­er plant at Galgu, a farming commu­nity in the Yendi Municipality of the Northern Region, is about 75 per cent to complete. The \$ 59 million plant is expected to be inaugurated in November this year to serve Yendi and its environs.

Plenitude, a subsidiary of Italian oil and gas company Eni, has opened Shaulder, a 50MW solar plant in Kazakhstan. Located close to Shaulder village in the Turkistan region, the solar plant has been built on 100 hectares of land.

The photovoltaic plant, spanning 100 hectares of land, will produce up to 90 GWh of electricity annually and will feature over 93,000 solar panels and an electrical substation. These components will be integrated into the local grid through a new overhead powerline extending for 7.5 kilometers.

Kazakhstan yendi solar project

The Kapshagay photovoltaic power station, one of the largest single solar power projects in the Central Asian country, is a part of the China-Kazakhstan green energy cooperation initiative, jointly invested in and constructed by the Chinese company Universal Energy and Kazakh counterparts.

The project is designed to produce up to 90 gigawatt hours of electricity annually with 93,000 panels and an electrical substation, according to operator Eni Plenitude Wind & Energy SRL.

Balkhash Solar PV Park is a 100MW solar PV power project. It is located in Karaganda Region, Kazakhstan. According to GlobalData, who tracks and profiles over 170,000 power plants worldwide, the project is currently active. It has been developed in multiple phases. Post completion of construction, the project got commissioned in June 2022.
