

What is the invest in Namibia energies Country Spotlight?

The Invest in Namibia Energies country spotlight represents just one of many spotlights set to take place during this year's edition of AEW. #AEW2023 takes place this week in Cape Town under a mandate to make energy poverty history by 2030.

What is happening in Namibia's energy sector?

Namibia's energy sector has seen rapid development in a short period of time owing to five recent major oil and gas discoveries, which include the Venus-1X, Graff-1X, Jonker-1X, La Rona-1X, and Lesedi-1X exploration projects.

What is the main source of energy in Namibia?

Wood or biomass is the main source of energy in the rural areas of Namibia, more specially in the northern and northeastern part of Namibia. About 87% of Namibians in the rural areas use wood or wood charcoal as the main energy for cooking, heating, and lighting as compared to only 16% in urban areas.

What is Namibia's energy policy?

The Namibian Energy Policy (also known as the White Paper on Energy) was adopted in 1998 as the overall policy framework for the energy sector in Namibia. The Energy Policy is currently under review.

Why should you invest in Namibia energy?

How many uranium mines are there in Namibia?

Namibia has two significant uranium mines capable of providing 10% of world mining output. A larger mine is set to start production. Its first commercial uranium mine began operating in 1976. There is strong government support for expanding uranium mining and some interest in using nuclear power.

The White Paper on Energy Policy was developed by the Energy Policy Committee of the Ministry of Mines and Energy, Namibia. It was released in May 1998, and states these energy policy goals: Effective energy sector governance ; Security of supply ; Social upliftment ; ...
