

Via ESN: " Voltalia commissions solar-plus-storage project on French Guiana with 10.6MWh BESS: French renewable energy company Voltalia has completed the expansion of a renewable energy plant in French Guiana, adding a battery energy storage system (BESS) of 10.6MWh. 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French renewable power plants operator Voltalia SA (EPA:VLTSA) on Monday announced the commissioning of the 3.8-MW Savane des Peres solar park in French Guiana, which has an integrated battery storage component.

Voltalia is the sole winner of the fifth period of the CRE 4 tender for non-interconnected areas for ground-based solar power plants in French Guiana. The project, called "Parc Sable Blanc", combines a five-megawatt photovoltaic power plant with a lithium-ion battery storage facility with a capacity of 5 megawatts and of 9.3 megawatt-hours.

An NREL presentation details the benefits and challenges of solar plus storage systems. Benefits can include reduced utility bills, reduced demand charges, and increased resilience, or the ability to meet critical load during grid outages.

French Guiana is an overseas department of France, located on the northeast coast of South America. The Sable Blanc BESS will timeshift the solar PV to the evening once production tails off under a 20-year tariff agreement and will replace diesel generator capacity.

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French hydrogen specialist HDF Energy has launched the Centrale Électrique de l'Ouest guyanais (CEOG) project, which promises to be one of the world's largest solar-plus-storage power plants.

According to official statistics from the MEEM, French Guiana had 34 MW of PV capacity without storage solutions (including stand-alone systems) and 5 MW of installed power consisting of solar-plus-storage solutions at the end of 2014.

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French renewable power producer Valtalia SA (EPA:VLTSA) has started the construction works on a 5-MW solar farm combined with a 10.6-MWh lithium-ion battery storage unit in French Guiana. Named Sable Blanc, the photovoltaic (PV) plant should be able to generate 7,430 MWh annually, enough to meet the electrical demands of 3,090 people in Western ...

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The European Investment Bank (EIB) has extended EUR 25 million (USD 29.3m) in debt to the company behind a project calling for the construction of a baseload renewable complex in French Guiana, combining solar, hydrogen, battery storage and fuel cells.
