What does the PNG Energy Authority do?

The Authority's core functions are policy making and regulation of the energy market, including electricity and downstream gas industry, under the energy laws in PNG.

Why does Papua New Guinea need affordable electricity?

"Access to reliable, affordable electricity is central to economic development; businesses, schools, hospitals and clinics, among countless other services in PNG, all need reliable, affordable power to keep the country growing," said Stefano Mocci, World Bank Country Manager for Papua New Guinea.

Why is Papua New Guinea so important?

In the years after the Kutubu discovery, Papua New Guinea became the subject of great investment interest as many major oil and gas companies scrambled to get Petroleum Prospecting Licences and as many as two dozen new field wildcat wells were drilled per year.

What is PPL doing for Papua New Guinea?

"PPL is embarking on major corporate reform initiatives," said Flagon Bekker, Managing Director of PPL. "We look forward to working alongside the World Bank team to put in place critical improvements that will ultimately deliver stronger, more reliable energy for all Papua New Guineans."

What is National Energy Authority (NEA)?

NEA exists to implement the National Energy Policy 2017 - 2027 to provide electricity for all households and businesses in PNG, by harnessing renewable energy sources and downstream gas industry in a sustainable way and for the prosperity of PNG. The Authority was established by virtue of the National Energy Authority Act 2021.
