Does the Pitcairn Islands have a marine environment?

Before 2011, the scientific evidence for the state of the marine environment of the Pitcairn Islands' exclusive economic zone (EEZ) was absent.

What is Pitcairn Island Marine Reserve?

The journey began in 2011, with a formal marine reserve proposal in 2013, support from the UK government, and the establishment of the Pitcairn Island Marine Reserve in 2015. Now, Pitcairn's marine science base ensures ongoing preservation efforts, protecting precious marine life for future generations.

What's new at the Pitcairn Islands?

Governor Iona Thomas opening the new Marine Science Base. Scientists from around the globe will be able to explore some of the world's most untouched marine habitats and potentially discover new life underwater thanks to the creation of a new marine science base on the remote Pitcairn Islands.

The Pitcairn Islands Marine Protected Area (MPA) Management Plan sets out ways to ensure effective management of the MPA over the next five years. Pitcairn Islands, encompassing four islands in a 43.25 km<sup>2</sup> area, achieved a significant milestone in March 2019.

How did Pitcairn Island become a marine sanctuary?

Beginning in 2011, the Pew Environment Group's Global Ocean Legacy project worked with the Pitcairn islanders to create this marine sanctuary. In 2012, a National Geographic expedition assessed the health of the marine environment around the islands, discovering thriving ecosystems and new species.

Why is the Pitcairn Islands so pristine?

Iona Thomas, Governor to Pitcairn and British High Commissioner to New Zealand, said: The ocean around the Pitcairn Islands is one of the most pristine places on earth and home to a treasure trove of sharks, fish, corals and other marine life not seen anywhere else in the world.
