Who is developing a new infrastructure in Africa - PIDG & Solveo?

The project is being developed by InfraCo Africa - which is part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG) -- and Solveo Energie, a subsidiary of Solveo Company, with the support of Aldwych Africa Developments.
