

Solar panels for home in Cuba

The opportunity now for individuals to import their own photovoltaic systems to Cuba, may change this situation. With just 20,000 solar water heaters and a million kWh every day of energy installed in its photovoltaic parks, Cuba is basically wasting the vast majority of the solar energy it has available.

Importación desde el exterior por personas naturales a su ingreso a Cuba. Paso 1: Para ingresar a Cuba las personas naturales que importen sistemas fotovoltaicos y equipos que aprovechan las fuentes renovables de energía o que tienen una mayor eficiencia energética. Estos deberán ser presentados separados del resto de los artículos importados.

In Cuba, solar panels cost about 4 per watt on average. The average Cuba homeowner needs a 6.3-kilowatt system, which would cost about \$16,643 with the federal tax credit, or \$23,799 before the 0 tax credit is applied.

Large consumers in the residential sector could find in the installation of solar panels a way to offset the amount of their energy bill through cogeneration for self-consumption or receive a payment for injecting clean energy into the national power grid.

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Como parte de la estrategia que se realiza en Cuba para el desarrollo de las fuentes renovables, el Ministerio de Energía y Minas (Minem) aprobó a finales de 2021 una resolución que establece las regulaciones para que personas naturales y jurídicas contraten potencia solar fotovoltaica para autoabastecerse.

The Cuban Electricity Union (UNE) specified that an average household on the island needs around 185 kWh per month. To cover these needs, 5 solar panels of 260 watts are necessary. The importation of tax-free solar panels was in high demand by those who are eager to supply their own electricity, an increasingly precarious good on the Island.
