

In May, Nordic Solar inaugurated its first solar park in the Moletai region in Lithuania. With its production capacity of 100 MWp, this is the largest solar park built in the country so far.

With a capacity to produce power equivalent to the annual consumption of approximately 28,000 European households, the 100-MWp solar park stands as a testament to Lithuania's commitment to energy independence and its strategic focus on increasing renewable energy sources.

Since the start of the year, Nordic Solar has launched construction works on two solar parks in Lithuania with a total expected capacity of 180 MWp. The company is ready to start building another 60-MWp site before the end of 2023.
