Montenegro's transmission system operator, CGES, and Cetinje-based M Energy have signed the first agreement on connecting a planned solar power plant of 385 MW to the grid. The value of the project is around ...

Construction of a Solar Power Plant in Montenegro with a total capacity of up to 385 MW The Project site is located in central region of Montenegro in the area of Chevo which lies on the border between Cetinje and Nikšić municipalities, 68km away from Podgorica and 101km away from the Port of Bar.

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Montenegro has natural advantages for the use of green energy. The country's solar potential is one of the largest in Southeast Europe. The capital Podgorica, for example, has more than 2,000 hours of sunshine per year, while the number for Montenegro as a whole ranges from 1,300 to 2,000 a year.

RES Montenegro Group received the urban planning and technical requirements for a photovoltaic facility with a connection capacity of up to 506 MW. The project in Cetinje is the biggest in Montenegro and one of the largest ones in Southeastern Europe. The company Montenegro Investment and Holdings achieved the same milestone for a 12.5 MW facility.

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
