Where does Trinidad and Tobago get its energy from?

This page is part of Global Energy Monitor's Latin America Energy Portal. Trinidad and Tobago derives almost all of its energy from domestically produced hydrocarbons, especially natural gas.

Who owns natural gas in Trinidad & Tobago?

State-owned National Gas Company is responsible for the purchase, sale, transmission, distribution, and aggregation of Trinidad and Tobago's natural gas resources. POWERGEN (Power Generation Company of Trinidad and Tobago) is the leading independent power producer in the country.

Who regulates the energy sector in Trinidad & Tobago?

The MEEI (Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries) manages Trinidad and Tobago's oil, gas, and mineral resources. The MEEI is responsible for monitoring, controlling, and regulating the country's energy and mineral sectors. The Regulated Industries Commission also serves as a regulator for the energy sector.

How does Trinidad and Tobago's energy sector affect economic growth?

The performance of Trinidad and Tobago's energy sector has far-reaching implications for the country's macroeconomic indicators and fundamentals such as fiscal stability, export earnings, foreign exchange reserves and overall economic growth.

What is the Nationally Determined Contribution plan for Trinidad & Tobago?

The government's Nationally Determined Contribution plan released in 2018 calls for Trinidad and Tobago's power generation, transportation, and industrial sectors to reduce emissions by 15% relative to business as usual by 2030. The MEEI (Ministry of Energy and Energy Industries) manages Trinidad and Tobago's oil, gas, and mineral resources.

Will Trinidad & Tobago bring gas from Loran field?

Trinidad and Tobago also expects to resume negotiations to bring gas from the Loran field for processing. Crude oil exports averaged 1,660,000 barrels per month between January 2022 and April 2023.
