The new Virgin Islands Solar for All Program has the power to transform the U.S. Virgin Island's residential energy landscape, addressing residents' high electricity costs while creating new opportunities for energy ...

The innovative financing program offered Virgin Island resident's loans of up to \$30,000 to use towards the installation of solar photovoltaic (PV), and solar PV systems built in conjunction with battery storage.

This program is exclusively available to full-time USVI homeowners with no existing solar installed. Selected applicants will receive a 15-year loan with an annual interest rate of 1% to install an approved solar energy system tied into the Territory's power grid.

The Spanish Town solar farm in St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands--in operation since 2015--received significant damage during the 2017 hurricanes. The plant remained offline for nearly 5 months, while grid repairs were implemented, and production was limited to less than 45 percent of its energy capacity once reenergized.

The adjoining solar facilities will provide a total of 140 MW solar capacity. The solar-plus-storage system is expected to fulfill 30% of the islands' energy consumption needs. According to the Department of Energy (DOE), the U.S. Virgin Islands have heavily relied on fossil fuels to generate electricity in the past.

The U.S. Virgin Islands (USVI) Energy Office is the managing agency for USVI's Weatherization Assistance Program spite geographic isolation, high retail electricity rates, and vulnerability to natural disasters that wreak havoc in island communities, USVI was able to weatherize 444 homes between 2010 and 2021 with annual formula funds from WAP.
