How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

How does a solar panel installation work?

The installer will have to lift some of the roof tiles to fix the anchors to the rafters in the loft. This will give the solar panel mounts a stable foundation, and will make sure they don't get damaged in stormy weather. Once the roof anchors have been fixed to the property, the installer will attach the solar panel mounting system to them.

Why should you install solar panels?

Installing solar panels lets you use free, renewable, low carbon electricity. You can sell surplus electricity to the grid or store it for later use. According to low-carbon certification organisation MCS, there were more than 183,000 solar panel installations across the UK in 2023.

What is a solar PV system?

Solar PV systems - a collection of solar panels - turn sunlight into electricity through the 'solar cells' they contain. These cells are made from thin layers of a 'semiconductor' material (traditionally silicon) between layers of glass.

How do solar photovoltaic panels work?

Solar photovoltaic panels transform free energy from the sun into electricity. This is then converted from a DC current to an AC current via an inverter, to make it suitable for household use. The panels capture energy from the sun and convert it into DC electricity via groups of photovoltaic (PV) cells.
